CONTENUR showcased the company's flagship products, such as the new 2200F Side-loading model with electronic lock.














A delegation from Singapore visits CONTENUR

Innovative Concept



CONTENUR open for business in Taiwan

CONTENUR started operating in Taiwan with the supply of containers for urban waste in the main cities on the island.

Taiwan, on the East China Sea, has a population of approximately 23 million inhabitants and an economy which has been growing over the last thirty years. It is known as one of the Four Asian Tigers, along with Singapore, Hong Kong and South Korea.

The company we have been supplying the containers to has initially chosen 120, 240 and 360 litre capacity

rear-loading containers, which will be distributed in the larger populated areas of the country, such as Taipei, Taichung, Kaohsiung and Taoyuan.

The start of business activity in this region, where CONTENUR has recently opened a branch office, is a step forward in our growth strategy. We are already seeing regular business activity in Singapore and Malaysia.

Renewal of supply and maintenance contracts in France

CONTENUR France has renewed two large supply and maintenance contracts in the regions of Versailles Grand Parc and Île de France.

Throughout this first half of the year, Versailles Grand Parc has decided to renew the supply and maintenance contract of the region's container fleet, showing that CONTENUR has achieved the aim of the improving on the customer service and product quality it has been providing over the last 4 years.

In the Île de France region, CONTENUR has acquired a new contract in Grand Paris Seine Ouest, the second largest area after Plaine Commune. The contract includes maintenance of the container fleet and repair or replacement of containers in poor condition.













CONTENUR to manage cleaning and maintenance services in Cartagena de Indias

CONTENUR has recently opened a new operational base in Cartagena de Indias (Colombia), from where it will manage all cleaning and maintenance services of the container fleet in this Colombian city. The base has a warehouse and repair materials for this purpose.

The contract, signed with the two operators in the city (Aseo Urbano de la Costa and Pacaribe), includes mechanical washing of the containers, involving on site container cleaning, performed using a container cleaning vehicle, which provides pressurised water and environmentally friendly additives. This type of maintenance also includes the cleaning of the space underneath and around the container.

New to the market

This vehicle is one of few to offer this service in Latin America in compliance with the requisite container cleaning standards. There are multiple benefits to this, not only in terms of the visual appearance of the containers, but also for the improvement of sanitation levels and environmental benefits.

Maintenance experience

CONTENUR has a highly qualified team with vast experience in handling container inspection, maintenance and repair tasks.

CONTENUR supply Side-Loading containers in Turkey

CONTENUR have supplied Side-Loading Model D containers with a 3,200 litre capacity to the largest company in the AKMERÇAN group. AKMERÇAN is a pioneer in the installation of more efficient waste collection systems.

The first side-loading containers, both at street level and underground, were supplied by CONTENUR two years ago in the municipal district of Başakşehir, operated by AKMERÇAN.

Başakşehir is one of the main municipal districts in Istanbul and two other large municipal districts in Istanbul operated by AKMERÇAN (Bağcılar and Küçükçekmece) have also started using CONTENUR side-loading containers.

Contemar installs mechanised waste collection systems in Capela do Alto

Contemar's sales team have undertaken a project to install mechanised waste collections systems in the Brazilian city of Capela do Alto. The plan, which has been financed entirely by the State Government of Sao Paolo, is to be rolled out in two phases. The first phase will involve the installation of 1,000 litre CONTENUR containers and litter bins in the city centre, and the second phase (forecast for 2017) will supply and install waste containers in the region's rural areas.

In order to successfully implement this containerisation project in the area, we have carried out a prior public awareness project, in which Contenur has worked closely with the local council to demonstrate the benefits of urban containerisation to the inhabitants of this municipal district.

New installation of underground containers

Contemar has installed seven underground containers in one of Brazil's most prominent tourist destinations, Ilha Bela beach in Sao Paolo State.

Although initially we have only supplied 7 units in the busiest tourist areas, the city council has plans to install more underground containers across the city.

Supply of igloos in the Brazilian city of Florianópolis

Contemar won the council tender for glass collection in the city of Florianópolis, capital of Santa Catarina State.

This is a new initiative in the Brazilian market, where glass collection by crane-lift containers is uncommon. The tender will supply 170 igloos, which will be installed across the city.

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New side-loading containers supplied in Spain

CONTENUR has been awarded contracts for the supply of new side-loading containers in the Spanish cities of Alcantarilla, Burjassot and Alcobendas.

Alcobendas and Burjassot have chosen the 3,200 litre side-loading container, whilst Alcantarilla Council has opted for the lower capacity 2,200 litre model for the collection of MSW, as this is best suited to the city's landscape.

Burjassot Council are renovating their MSW containers. Plastics are going to be in yellow containers and paper and cardboard blue. FCC, a contractor for the collection of waste in the municipal district, has already started work on substituting the old containers for the new ones. All models include an adhesive label on

the lid with useful information for the public on waste collection times and the importance of separating waste and depositing it in the corresponding container.

The side-loading containers in Alcobendas are intended for the collection of MSW and are embossed with the Council crest on the body of the container. In Alcantarilla, meanwhile, the 2,200 litre model has a 400mm aperture at the front of the container to facilitate waste disposal.

The containers intended for recycling plastics and packaging have two front apertures situated 1180mm from the ground. Both models have heat transfers featuring the municipal district logos.

CONTENUR to manage maintenance services for children's playgrounds in Segovia, San Fernando de Henares and Paterna

CONTENUR has won the contracts for the provision of inspection and maintenance services in children's playgrounds in the Spanish cities of Segovia, San Fernando de Henares and Paterna.

The maintenance contracts in Segovia and San Fernando de Henares encompass the total areas currently covered by each of these cities (54 in Segovia and 47 in San Fernando de Henares). The work to be carried out will comply with the requirements for the provision of these services, as established in Regulation UNE EN 1176-7:2008, and consists of conducting visual and physical inspections, testing and cleaning the playgrounds and apparatus and any preventive and corrective maintenance.

The contract term in Segovia is 4 years, whilst in San Fernando de Henares it is 2 years.

In Paterna, the maintenance and adaptation contract for children's playgrounds includes all work stipulated by this regulation, in addition to all the necessary work to adapt and certify all areas. This is a 1 year contract with the option to renew for another year.

This work will be performed in all the city's playgrounds, including those belonging to local state schools.

Last April saw the "Innovation in the Circular Economy" seminar take place at the ETSI de Montes de la Universidad Politécnica de Madrid engineering school, organised by the Cátedra Ecoembes de Medio Ambiente.
