ICONIC SPAIN LANDMARKS



SAGRADA FAMÍLIA (BARCELONA)

Antoni Gaudí's visionary basilica, the Sagrada Família, stands as one of the most extraordinary architectural projects in history. Its sky-piercing towers and facades tell intricate biblical stories through stone, blending Gothic traditions with Gaudí's unique organic modernism. Under construction since 1882, each visit reveals new progress, making it as captivating today as it will be upon completion, a living masterpiece that evolves before your eyes.

ALHAMBRA (GRANADA)

Perched on a hill overlooking Granada, the Alhambra is a breathtaking testament to Moorish artistry and power. This vast palace and fortress complex enchants with its delicate stucco work, geometric tile patterns, and peaceful courtyards framed by slender columns. The scent of orange blossoms lingers in its gardens, while sweeping views of the Sierra Nevada mountains remind visitors of its strategic beauty. PARK GÜELL (BARCELONA)

A kaleidoscope of color and imagination, Park Güell is Antoni Gaudí's playful vision brought to life in a public space. ROYAL PALACE OF MADRID

The Royal Palace of Madrid, Europe's largest by floor area, is an opulent showcase of Spanish monarchy and craftsmanship. Housing more than 3,000 rooms, it boasts gilded halls, ornate frescoes, crystal chandeliers, and priceless art collections. Still used for state ceremonies, the palace transports visitors into a world of baroque elegance and political grandeur. SEVILLE CATHEDRAL & LA GIRALDA

Dominating Seville's historic center, the Cathedral of Saint Mary of the See is the largest Gothic cathedral in the world and a marvel of medieval ambition. Inside lies the ornate tomb of Christopher Columbus, surrounded by soaring arches and luminous stained glass. Adjacent, the Giralda bell tower—once a minaret—offers panoramic views over the city's tiled rooftops and fragrant orange groves. Together, they embody the fusion of Moorish and Christian heritage.
