SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

The Serengeti is Tanzania's most famous safari destination and one of the greatest wildlife regions in the world. 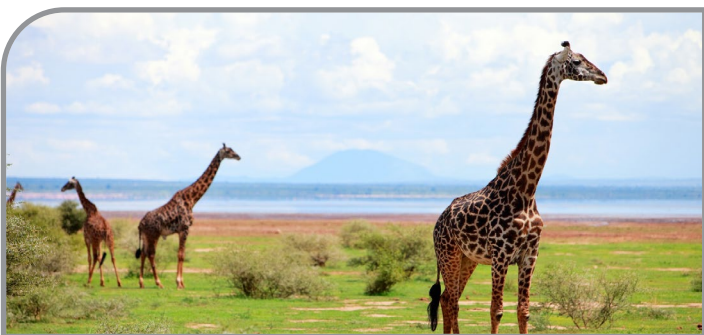
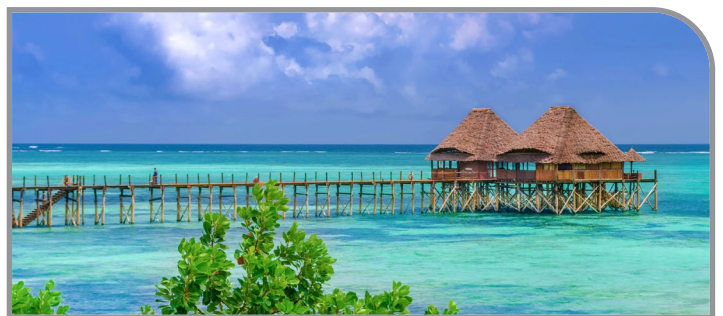


MOUNT KILIMANJARO

ZANZIBAR & STONE TOWN

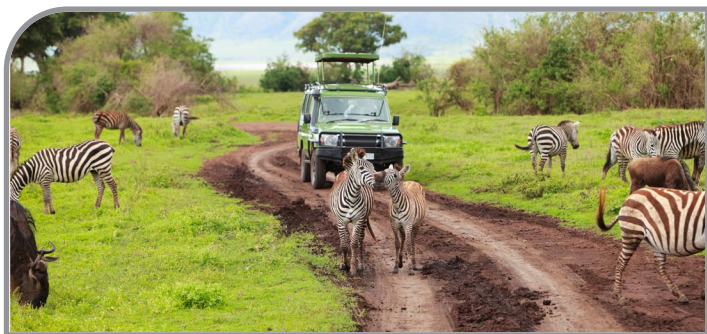
