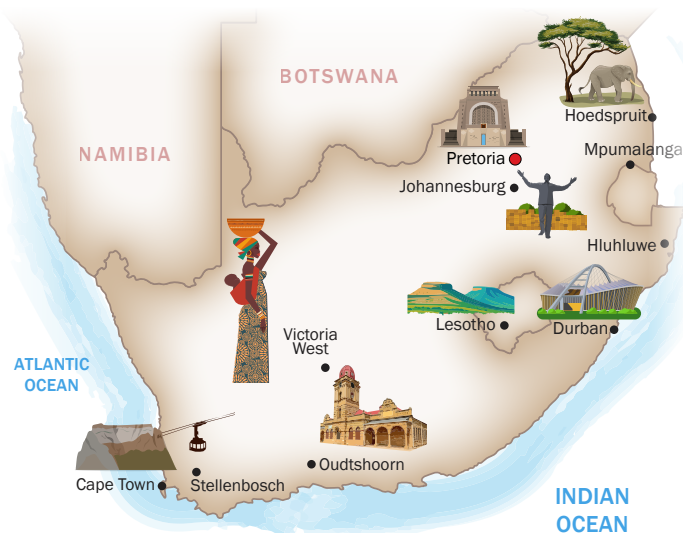

ICONIC SOUTH AFRICA LANDMARKS

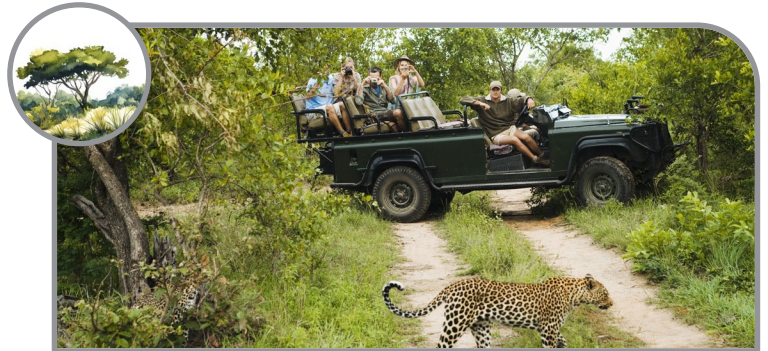


TABLE MOUNTAIN (CAPE TOWN)

Dominating Cape Town's skyline, Table Mountain is a flat-topped marvel offering sweeping views of the city, coastline, and surrounding mountains. Visitors can ascend via the rotating cable car or hike scenic trails through Table Mountain National Park, a biodiversity hotspot home to unique plants and wildlife. Recognized as one of the New 7 Wonders of Nature, it's an iconic symbol of South Africa's natural beauty.

KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

Spanning nearly 20,000 square kilometers, Kruger National Park is one of Africa's premier safari destinations, renowned for its incredible wildlife diversity. Home to the Big Five—lion, elephant, buffalo, rhino, and leopard, it offers self-drive and guided safari experiences across varied landscapes. Visitors can stay in luxury lodges or rustic camps, encountering everything from open savannas to dense bushveld.

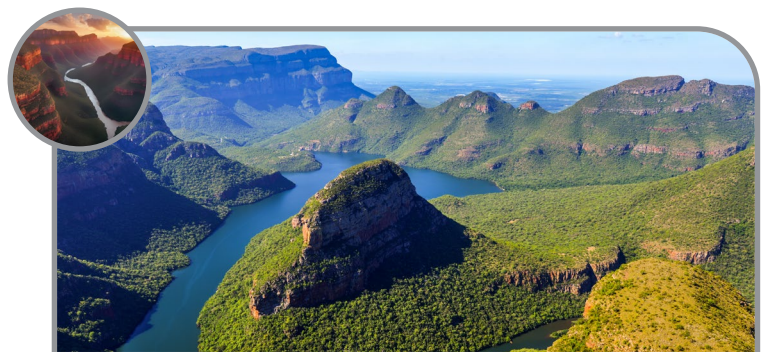


ROBBEN ISLAND

Located in Table Bay, Robben Island is a UNESCO World Heritage Site with a powerful history. For decades, it served as a prison for political activists, most famously Nelson Mandela, who spent 18 years here. Guided tours, often led by former inmates, share deeply personal stories of life under apartheid, resilience, and the fight for freedom. The island also offers stunning views of Cape Town and Table Mountain.

BLYDE RIVER CANYON

Carved by the Blyde River, this is one of the world's largest green canyons, famed for its lush subtropical vegetation and striking sandstone cliffs. Located in Mpumalanga, it features natural wonders such as God's Window, Bourke's Luck Potholes, and the Three Rondavels. Visitors can enjoy hiking trails, viewpoints, and waterfalls while taking in panoramic vistas of this breathtaking natural landscape.



CAPE OF GOOD HOPE

At the southwestern tip of Africa lies the Cape of Good Hope, a rugged promontory where the Atlantic and Indian Oceans meet. Its dramatic cliffs, wild beaches, and crashing waves make it a photographer's paradise. The area is rich in wildlife, from baboons and ostriches to seals and seabirds. 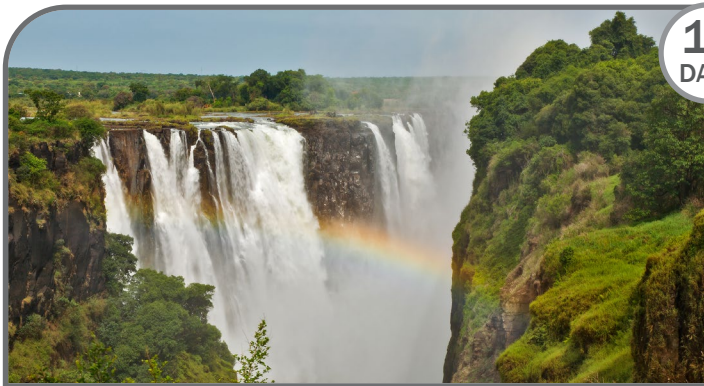
