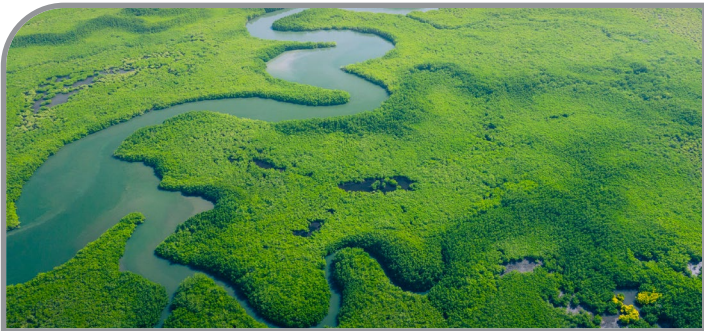


RIO DE JANEIRO & CHRIST THE REDEEMER

Towering above Rio de Janeiro, the statue of Christ the Redeemer stands as one of the New Seven Wonders of the World. With arms outstretched over the city, it offers sweeping views of beaches, mountains, and the shimmering Atlantic. Below, Rio's vibrant neighborhoods, legendary Copacabana and Ipanema beaches, and dramatic granite peaks create one of the world's most striking urban landscapes.

IGUAÇU FALLS

Straddling the border of Brazil and Argentina, Iguazu Falls is one of the most powerful and awe-inspiring waterfall systems on Earth. Nearly 300 cascades thunder through lush rainforest, sending mist high into the air and rainbows dancing across the sky. Walkways bring visitors thrillingly close to the roaring waters, offering an unforgettable encounter with nature's raw force.



THE AMAZON RAINFOREST

The Amazon is the planet's largest rainforest and one of its most vital ecosystems. Dense jungle, winding rivers, and extraordinary wildlife create a world that feels untouched by time.
