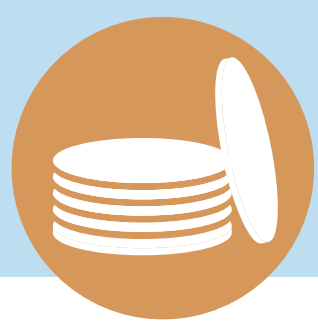

Hot air balloon ride at sunrise, explore ancient cave dwellings, and experience the unique beauty of this breathtaking region.



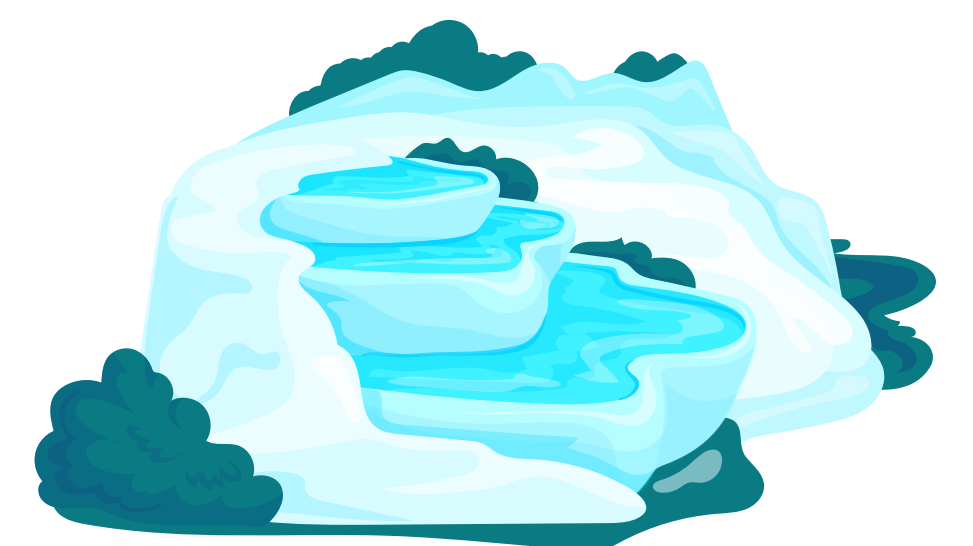
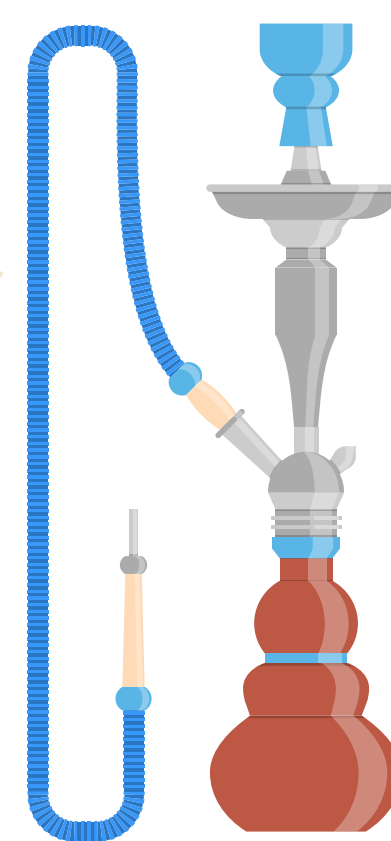
Dance Tidbits
