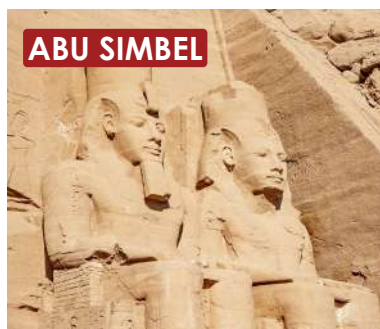

DAY 1 – ARRIVE CAIRO Arrive in the Land of the Pharaohs. Upon completion of immigration and customs formalities at Cairo International Airport, you will be met at the exit by our representative and escorted to your hotel.

DAY 2 – CAIRO - FULL DAY CAIRO PYRAMIDS & GEM MUSEUM WITH LUNCH Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before heading out for a full-day tour exploring Cairo's most iconic sites. Visit the Giza Plateau, home to the Great Pyramids of Khufu, Khafre, and Menkaure, as well as the enigmatic Sphinx. Continue to the Grand Egyptian Museum, where an extensive collection of ancient treasures awaits. Lunch is included at a local restaurant during your touring. Return to your hotel for an evening at leisure. (B,L)

DAY 3 – CAIRO / ALEXANDRIA / CAIRO - FULL DAY ALEXANDRIA EXCURSION WITH LUNCH Start your excursion to Alexandria by air-conditioned vehicle with an English-speaking Egyptologist as your guide. Visit the Catacombs of Kom-Alshukafa, the largest Roman Cemetery in Alexandria which is dated back to the second century. Discover Pompey's Pillar the most prominent remaining Greek landmark in Alexandria, then proceed to Visit the Roman Amphitheater, the center piece of the Kom al Dikka archaeological site. After lunch, visit Alexandria Library (The Bibliotheca Alexandrina), the largest library in the world now with 8 million books, then you will enjoy your drive along the Cornish to see the whole city passing over the Bridge of Stanley landmark of modern Alexandria on your way to Qaitbay fortress, built over the ruins of the ancient light house of Alexandria. Later in the evening, transfer back to Cairo. (B, L)

DAY 4 – CAIRO / LUXOR After breakfast, transfer to Cairo International Airport for your flight to Luxor. Upon arrival, transfer to your cruise ship. Accommodation on board consists of outside cabins with private facilities. Overnight onboard. (B,L,D)

DAY 5 – LUXOR / ESNA Have breakfast on board your Nile River vessel and then depart for an early morning visit to the West Bank where you will discover the Colossi of Memnon; the Valley of the Queens and the Valley of the Kings, burial sites for many of the most powerful and successful pharaohs and high priests; the Temple of Hatshepsut; and Medinet Habu Temple. Return for lunch on board as the ship sets sail to Esna. Overnight onboard. (B,L,D)

DAY 6 – ESNA / EDFU / KOM OMBO Continue the journey south for a brief stop at Edfu before sailing to Kom Ombo for a visit to the temple. This temple, unlike many others in Egypt, was dedicated to two gods; the Southern section is dedicated to Sobek, the crocodile headed man known as the god of fertility, and the Northern section to the falcon-headed god Horus. There is also a fascinating crocodile museum to visit with many artifacts and mummified crocodiles. Overnight onboard. (B,L,D)

DAY 7 – KOM OMBO / ASWAN Sail to Aswan and enjoy breakfast on board followed by a visit to the world-famous High Dam in Aswan, built in 1960-1971 to provide electricity to the villages along the Nile; see the Unfinished Obelisk, and explore the Temple of Isis on Philae Island. Lunch is on board followed by an afternoon at leisure with an opportunity to revisit the Temple of Philae for an optional sound and light show in the evening (extra cost). Overnight onboard. (B,L,D)

DAY 8 – ASWAN Early in the morning, transfer to Aswan Airport for your flight to Abu Simbel. Visit the Great Temple of Ramses II and the temple of his beloved Queen Nefertari. After visiting this magnificent site, you will be transferred to the airport for your flight back to Aswan. Upon arrival in Aswan, you will be transferred back to your ship. Have lunch onboard, followed by sailing along the Nile by felucca around Kitchener's Island and Agha Khan Mausoleum. Overnight onboard. (B,L,D)

DAY 9 – ASWAN / EDFU Sail to Edfu where you will visit to the Temple of Horus, the falcon god. Dating from 237 B.C., it is considered the best-preserved temple in Egypt and the second largest after the Temple of Karnak. Overnight onboard overnight. (B,L,D)

DAY 10 – EDFU / ESNA / LUXOR Enjoy breakfast on board as you sail to pass through the Esna Lock and continue sailing towards Luxor. After lunch, head out for a visit to the "world's largest greatest open-air museum" at the Karnak Temple complex, covering a large area of land and featuring several temples, including the impressive Temple of Amun. Enjoy one last visit to Luxor Temple then return to the ship. Overnight onboard (B,L,D)

DAY 11 – LUXOR / CAIRO Disembark and transfer to the airport for scheduled flight to Cairo. Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. (B)

DAY 1 – ARRIVE CAIRO Arrive in the Land of the Pharaohs. Upon completion of immigration and customs formalities at Cairo International Airport, you will be met at the exit by our representative and escorted to your hotel.

DAY 2 – CAIRO – FULL DAY CAIRO PYRAMIDS & GEM MUSEUM WITH LUNCH Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before heading out for a full-day tour exploring Cairo's most iconic sites. Visit the Giza Plateau, home to the Great Pyramids of Khufu, Khafre, and Menkaure, as well as the enigmatic Sphinx. Continue to the grand Egyptian Museum, where an extensive collection of ancient treasures awaits. Lunch is included at a local restaurant during your touring. Return to your hotel for an evening at leisure. (B,L)

DAY 3 – CAIRO / LUXOR Transfer from your hotel to Cairo Airport for your morning flight to Luxor. Upon arrival you will be escorted to your Nile cruise ship. Savor lunch on board before heading out with your guide to visit the impressive Karnak Temple and the Luxor Temple. The Temple of Karnak, located on the East bank of the Nile, was built by several great kings of Egypt including King Ramses II, King Tutmosis III, and Queen Hatshepsut. It was dedicated to the triad of Thebes: god Amun Ra, goddess Mut, and god Khonsu. Luxor Temple was dedicated to the god Amun and contains structures from many periods, the earliest dating back to the 12th Dynasty. Back on board, enjoy afternoon tea and dinner. Overnight onboard (B,L,D)

DAY 4 – LUXOR / ESNA Rise and shine with breakfast on board followed by a visit to the West Bank necropolis including the Valley of the Kings & Queens where magnificent tombs were carved into the desert rocks, decorated richly, and filled with treasures for the afterlife by generations of Pharaohs. Then visit the Funerary Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir El Bahari who ruled Egypt for almost 20 years. She chose a very well protected location as it is surrounded by the mountains. Enjoy lunch on board, sailing to Esna, and afternoon tea before the Captain's welcome cocktail party followed by dinner on board. Overnight onboard (B,L,D)

DAY 5 – ESNA / EDFU / KOM OMBO Sail to Edfu and have breakfast on board this morning. Today you will visit Edfu Temple. Totally submerged under the desert except for the very top of the pylon entrance, it is ancient Egypt's most complete and best-preserved temple. A small amount of stone had been removed from the exposed part, but when excavated it was found to be in near perfect condition. Enjoy lunch on board and afternoon tea before visiting the temple of Kom Ombo, uniquely dedicated to two gods. The southern half of the temple was dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek, while the northern part of the temple was

dedicated to the falcon god Haroeris. Later, join in the Galabeya party and dinner on board. Overnight onboard (B,L,D)

DAY 6 – KOM OMBO / ASWAN Sail to Aswan and enjoy breakfast on board followed by a visit to the world-famous High Dam, an engineering miracle when it was built in the 1960s. The dam was completed in 1971 and the huge reservoir behind it, named for President Nasser, was finished filling in 1979. The High Dam provided about half of the electricity production in Egypt, bringing power to most of Egypt's villages for the first time. By regulating the flow of the river, the dam also increased the cultivatable land in Egypt by around 30 percent and allowed development in new areas that were previously inundated annually when the river flooded. Later, visit the Granite Quarries and see the unfinished obelisk; discover Philae Temple that rose to prominence during the Ptolomaic Dynasty as the center of the cult of the goddess Isis. Have lunch on board, followed by sailing along the Nile by felucca around Kitchener's Island and Agha Khan Mausoleum. Sip on afternoon tea, and then enjoy the Nubian Folkloric show followed by dinner on board. Overnight onboard (B,L,D)

DAY 7 – ASWAN / CAIRO Early in the morning, optional Abu Simbel excursion by plane from Aswan (extra at cost). Transfer from your Nile Cruise to Aswan Airport for your morning flight to Cairo. Upon arrival you will be escorted to your Cairo Hotel. The remainder of the day is at leisure. (B)

DAY 8 – FULL DAY EGYPTIAN CIVILIZATION MUSEUM, CITADEL & KHAN EL KHALILI WITH LUNCH After enjoying your breakfast, you will visit the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization, home to a rich and diverse collection that spans Egypt's history from prehistoric times through the modern era. 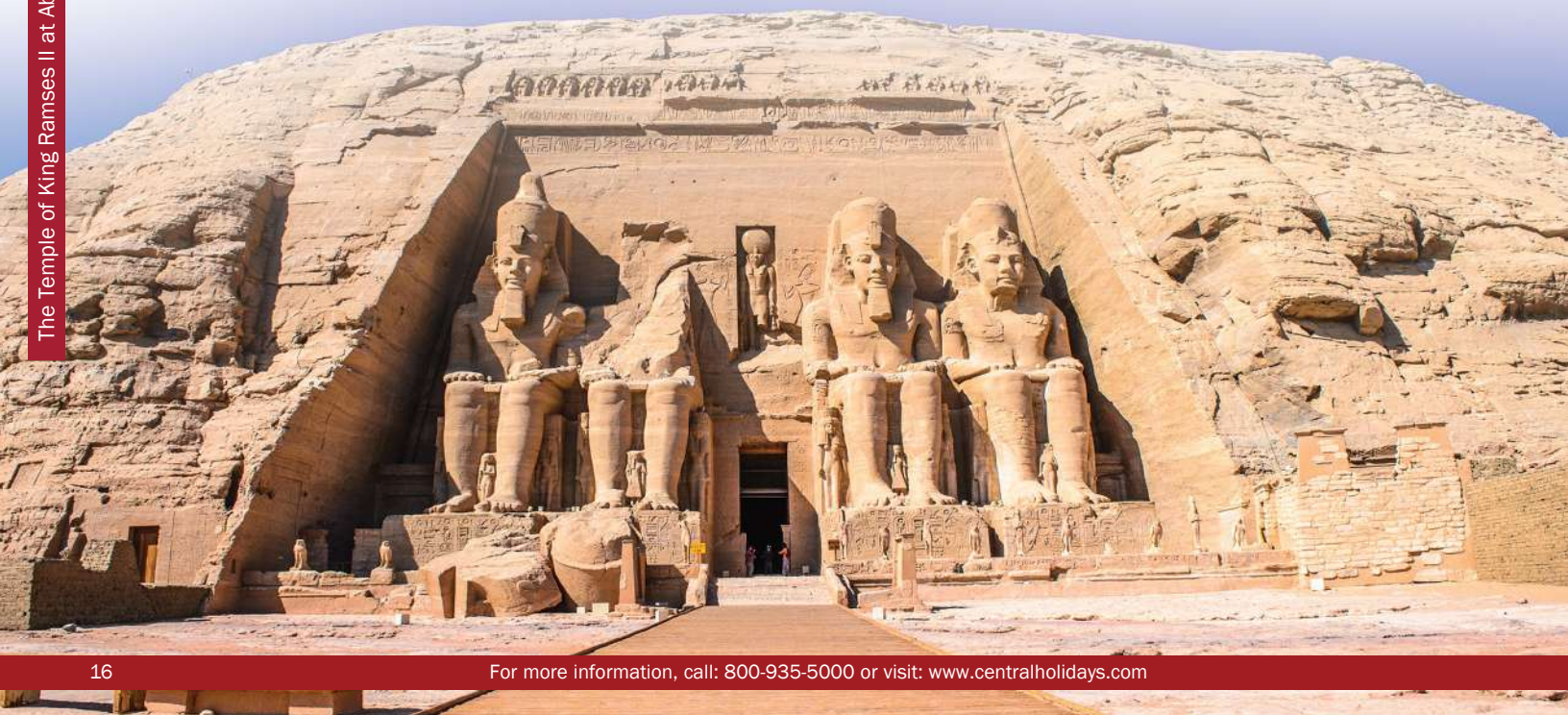

The southern half of the temple was dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek, while the northern part of the temple was dedicated to the falcon god Haroeris. DAY 6 - KOM OMBO / ASWAN Sail to Aswan and enjoy breakfast on board followed by a visit to the world-famous High Dam, an engineering miracle when it was built in the 1960s. The dam was completed in 1971 and the huge reservoir behind it, named for President Nasser, was finished filling in 1979. in Egypt by around 30 percent and allowed development in new areas that were previously inundated annually when the river flooded. Later, visit the Granite Quarries and see the unfinished obelisk; discover Philae Temple that rose to prominence during the Ptolemaic Dynasty as the center of the cult of the goddess Isis. 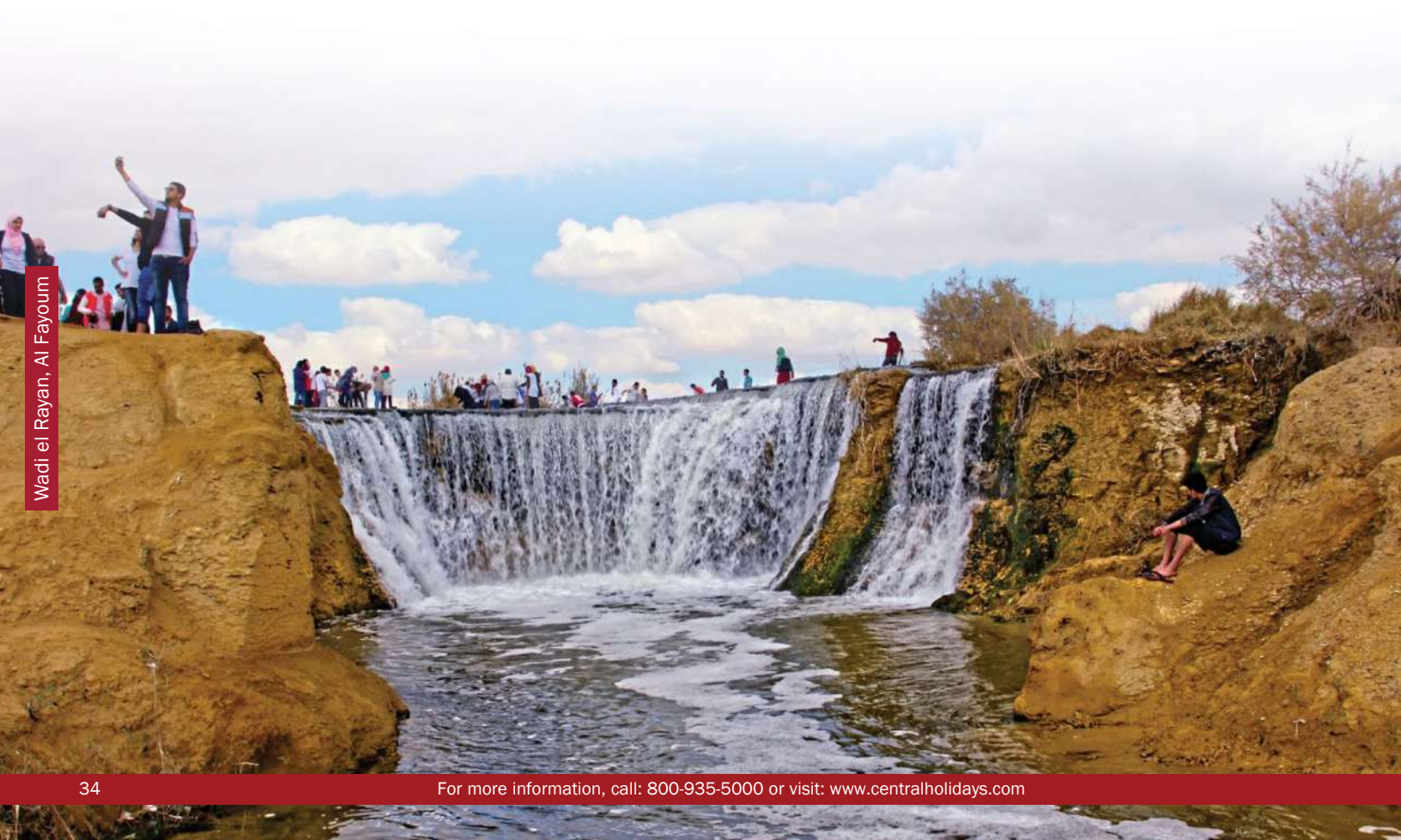

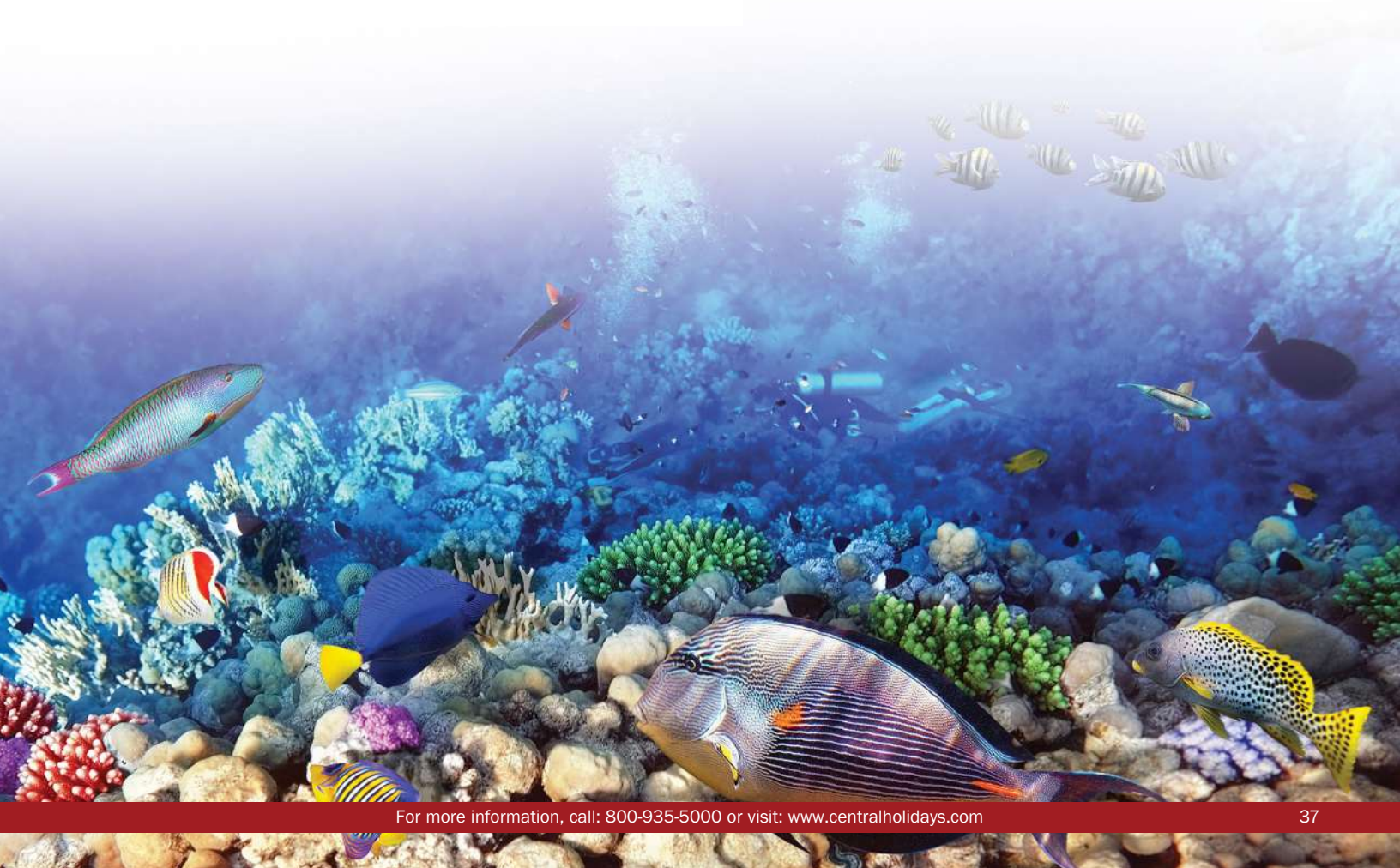

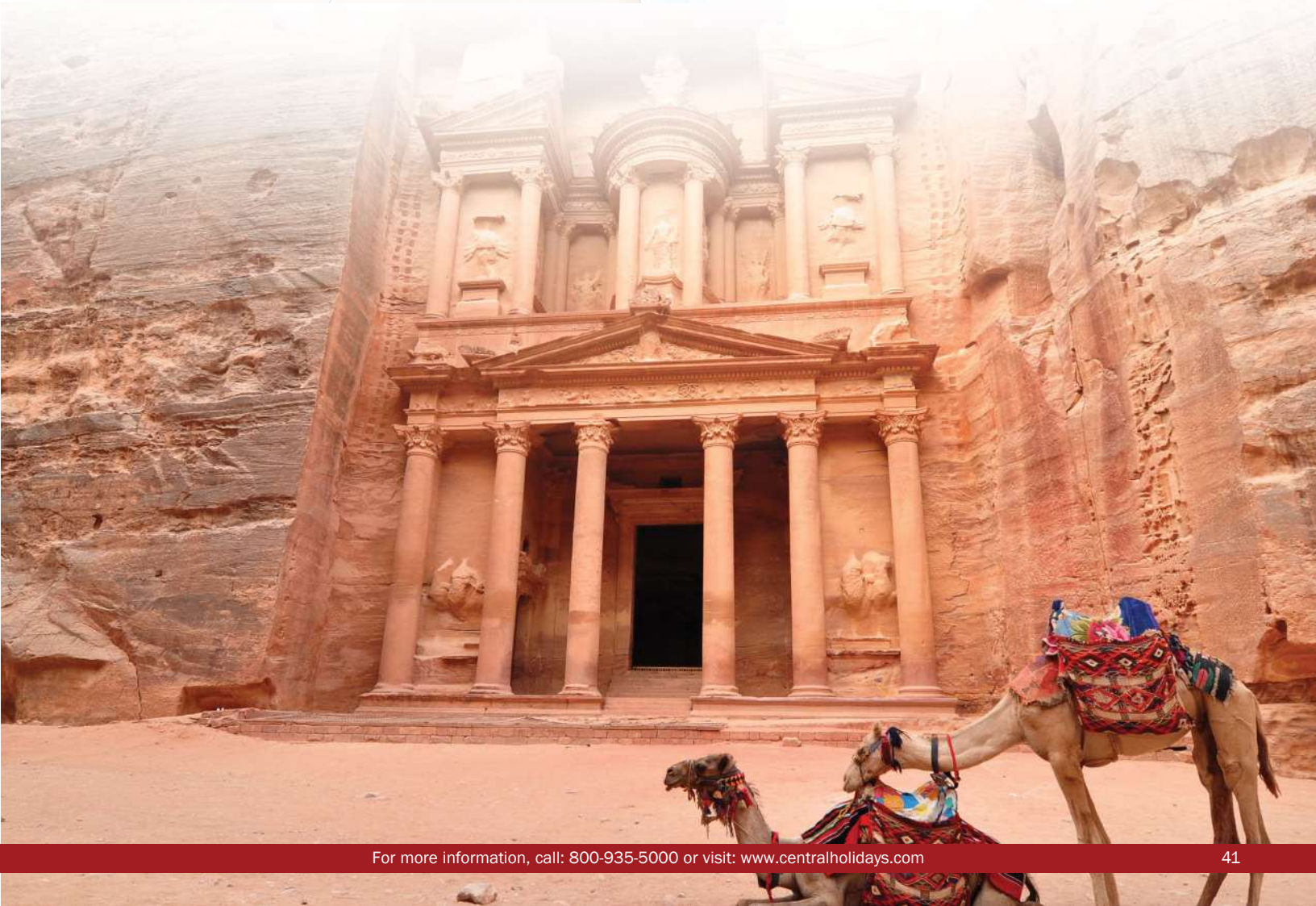

KOSHARI



A beloved street food and national dish of Egypt, koshari is a hearty, carb-rich bowl combining rice, lentils, chickpeas, elbow macaroni, and crispy fried onions, all smothered in a spicy, tangy tomato-garlic sauce.

FUL MEDAMES



One of Egypt's oldest traditional dishes, ful medames features slow-cooked fava beans mashed with olive oil, lemon juice, garlic, and cumin. Typically eaten for breakfast, it's served with warm baladi bread, boiled eggs, and pickled vegetables.

TA'MEYA (FALAFEL)



The Egyptian version of falafel, ta'meya is made with fava beans instead of chickpeas, giving it a bright green interior thanks to the fresh herbs blended in. Crispy on the outside and soft inside, it's a favorite sandwich filling, often served with salad and tahini.

MOLOKHIA (GREEN SOUP)



This thick, green stew made from jute leaves is infused with garlic and coriander, giving it a distinct earthy flavor. Often served with rice and roasted chicken or rabbit, molokhia has a slightly viscous texture that's beloved by locals and debated by foreigners.

MAHSHI



Mahshi is a family favorite featuring vegetables like zucchini, bell peppers, eggplant, and grape leaves stuffed with a savory mixture of rice, herbs, and sometimes minced meat, all simmered in tomato broth. It's aromatic, juicy, and deeply satisfying.

HAMAM MAHSHI



A gourmet dish of stuffed pigeon, hamam mahshi features squab birds filled with a spiced rice or freekeh mixture and then grilled or roasted. Tender, flavorful, and rich, this dish is considered a delicacy and a must-try for the adventurous eater.

SAYADIYA



Hailing from Egypt's coastal cities like Port Said and Alexandria, sayadiya is a fragrant dish of white fish simmered with rice, caramelized onions, and warming spices. It's often finished with lemon and tahini sauce for an extra flavor punch.

BASBOUSA



This beloved dessert is made from semolina soaked in sugar syrup and topped with coconut flakes or almonds. Sweet, moist, and delicately crumbly, basbousa is often served during holidays and special occasions alongside tea or coffee.

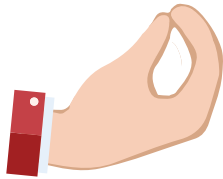

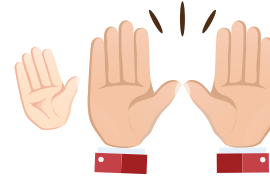

WAIT A MOMENT



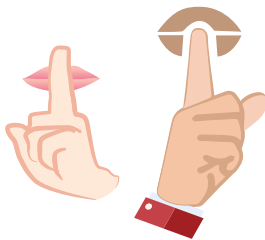
The hand is held up with fingers together, palm facing outward, and moved up and down slightly. A polite request for someone to pause or wait. Commonly used in conversations to interject or ask for a brief pause.

“NO” OR “I DON’T KNOW”



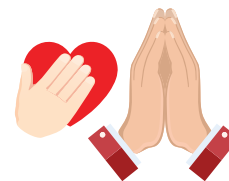
The hand is tilted side to side with the palm facing upward. Denial, uncertainty, or lack of knowledge about something. Frequently used in response to questions or when expressing uncertainty.

BE PATIENT



The index finger is placed vertically against the lips. A request for silence or patience. Used to calm situations or ask someone to wait quietly.

THANK YOU



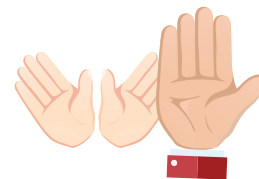
The right hand is placed over the heart, expressing heartfelt gratitude. Often accompanies verbal thanks to emphasize sincerity.

COME HERE



The hand is extended with the palm facing down, and fingers are moved in a scooping motion toward the body. Inviting someone to approach. Commonly used to beckon someone over in a friendly manner.

“ENOUGH” OR “STOP”



One Hand, or Both hands are raised with palms facing outward, fingers spread. A strong signal to stop or that something is sufficient, used in situations requiring immediate cessation of action.

ACCEPTANCE: The purchase/payment of any travel services offered by Central Holidays constitutes a contractual arrangement between the Passenger and/or Travel Agent (all together as "You") and SGI US LLC (dba CENTRAL HOLIDAYS & affiliated brands) ("Central Holidays") and represents your acceptance of SGI US LLC Terms and Conditions ("Terms and Conditions"). You are required to read and acknowledge the Terms and Conditions on our website before making any reservation with us. Payment of deposit and/or final payment will be considered as full, explicit and implicit acceptance of our Terms and Conditions herein reported and fully disclosed on our website. Each Passenger understands that Central Holidays will be accepting that Passenger's reservation in trust upon such Passenger's acceptance of the Terms and Conditions as outlined in this brochure and on our website.

2. TOUR PRICES/PRICE GUARANTEE: Prices are based on official rates of exchange at the time of Quote. Once we have received your full payment for any program/ reservation, the price is guaranteed. Optional air transportation is not included (unless otherwise noted). However, if optional air transportation is purchased, then the fuel surcharge, all security fees, airport taxes and fees and/or any other governmental or local taxes and fees will be included. Airfares provided at the time of deposit are subject to change until full payment is received and the ticket is issued. Some airfares may require instant purchase and are subject to the respective airline's regulations, terms and conditions of purchase. We strongly recommend you purchase air transportation through Central Holidays. In case of a human or computer billing error, we reserve the right to re-invoice for the correct amount. 3.B. FINAL PAYMENT: Final payments are due 60 days prior to commencement of first service or as indicated upon initial reservation. This timeline may vary based on suppliers' provisions. Passengers will be advised at the time of booking of payment requirements and obligations. If payment is not received by the determined due date, Central Holidays reserves the right to re-price or cancel the booking and will apply the assessed cancellation penalties accordingly. 5.D. SIGHTSEEING & OPTIONAL EXCURSIONS Sightseeing is included as per "Included Features" (on Escorted programs) and is under the direction of licensed local guides where required. Entrance fees to all places visited are included where indicated. 6. TRAVEL INFO & RESTRICTIONS:

A. OWN FLIGHT ARRANGEMENTS: If you purchase your own flight tickets from companies other than Central Holidays, Central Holidays is not responsible for the cancellation fees of air tickets if Central Holidays cancels a departure for any reason whatsoever, including a cancellation of a pledged departure for lack of participation or force majeure. If you wish to purchase your own flight tickets with a third party, we suggest you purchase airline tickets that allow you to make changes or cancellations of flights subject to minimum penalties – none of such penalties are the responsibility of Central Holidays.

6.B. VISA & PASSPORTS U.S. Citizens require a valid US passport to travel overseas. Non-U.S. citizens should consult their travel agent or consulate. All Passengers are responsible for ensuring they have the proper travel documents and MUST CHECK with the respective consulates or visa agency to determine whether any visas are required. Passengers are also responsible for the validity of their passports, and we suggest checking with U.S. Department of State Rules/Regulations. 6.C. BAGGAGE HANDLING The passenger is required to check with their respective airline for baggage allowance size, weight and excess baggage fees. Overnight, Special Delivery, Saturday Delivery and shipments outside the continental USA are subject to additional shipping fees. Added fees are applicable if the issuance of documents is requested earlier than proposed.
