



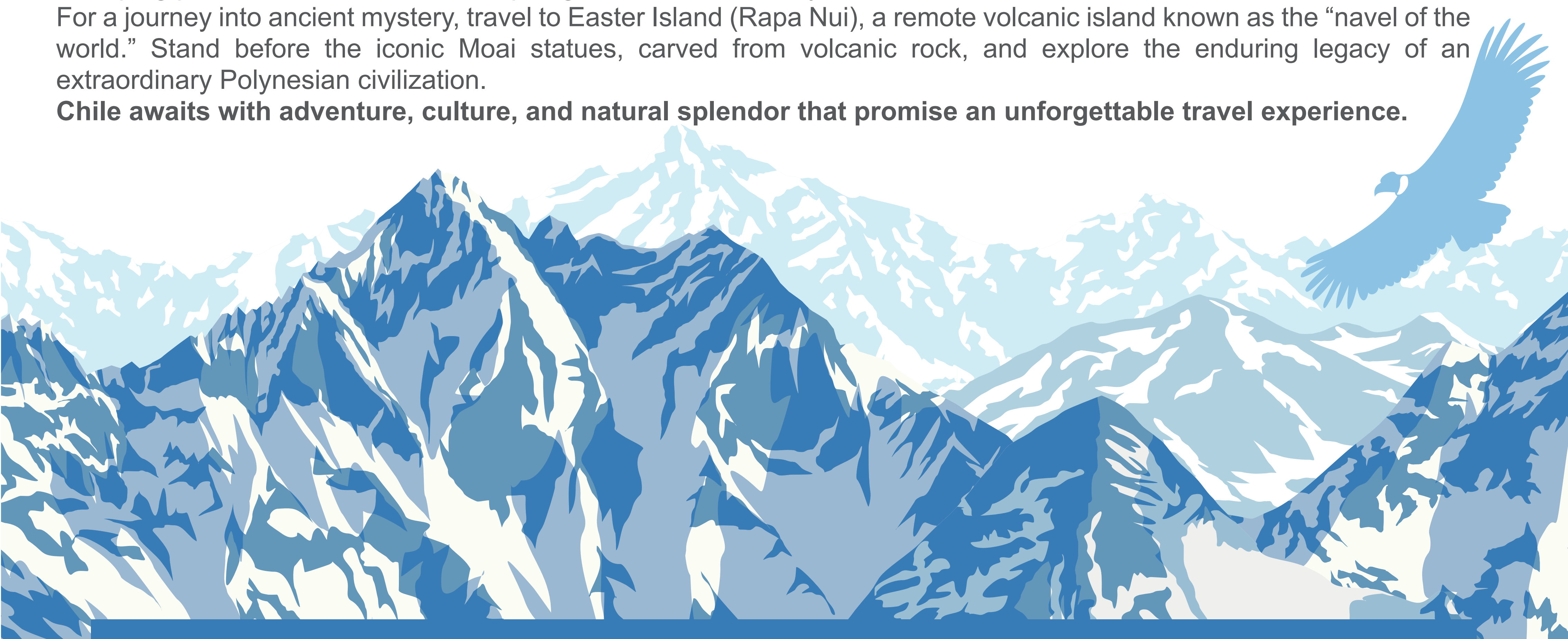

NATIONAL MUSEUM OF FINE ARTS

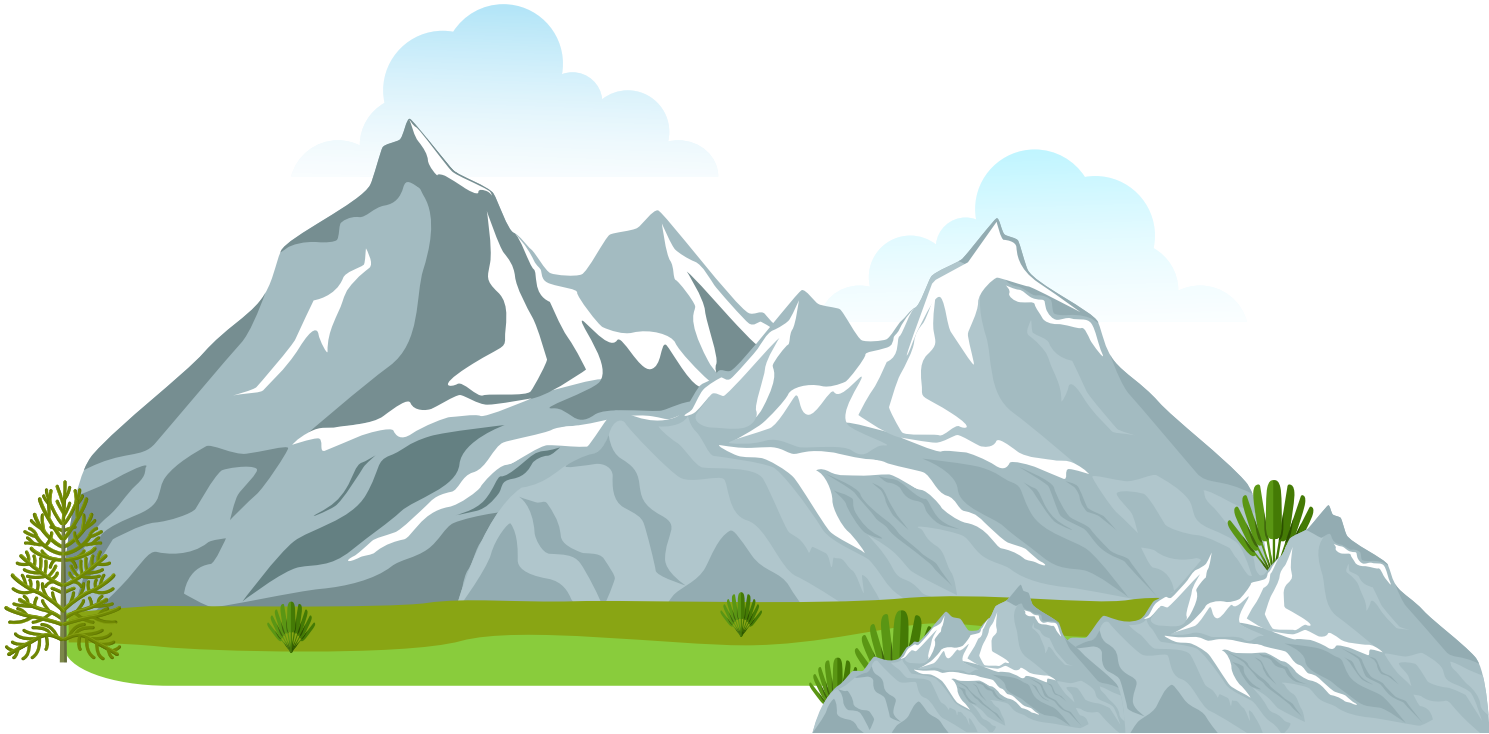
PATAGONIA
