

SHOVELS & SPADES

WOOD HANDLE – D TYPE



Use:

- **Spade:** The most common blade. It is used by masons to mix, and has a square shape. Good to soft ground such as sand or mud, as much material together. Not serve to make downward force, as they have no tabs to support the feet, and is half way inclined.
- **Shovel:** It has a curved shape with a slight edge at the tip, to cut the terrain. This edge also serves to better penetrate the grass, or on land very compact. It is better to break up the ground, rather than to join it, as the curved shape does not permit this material to the side, unless it is buried, and with downward force lever, to compact the material.

Characteristics:

- Made of hardened steel, highly resistant and tough wear and tear.
- High elasticity and durability. Resistant to deformation.
- Lightweight, comfortable and easy to use.
- Finish: black epoxy.
- Union between blade and handle reinforced.
- Handles eucalyptus wood varnished.

Packaging:

- Carton box with RUBI flexography on European pallet.
- Box's dimensions: 114x30x30 cm.
- 6 units per box.
- 6 boxes per pallet.
